You MUST obey instructions to keep event Covid 19 compliant!

All riders & non riders MUST have completed the online Covid Questionnaire in Clubhouse in advance. **NO HORSE OR RIDER SWAPS ARE ALLOWED ON THE DAY.**

DUE TO COVID & FC RESTRICTIONS PLEASE DO NOT BRING HELPERS or HANGER'S ON UNLESS REALLY NEEDED DO NOT ARRIVE MORE THAN 30 MINUTES BEFORE YOUR START TIME PLEASE MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING AT ALL TIMES

DIRECTIONS:

From A556, turn onto B5152 opposite Vale Royal Abbey Arms, towards Delamere and Frodsham.
VENUE is on right, past Delamere railway station.

ON ARRIVAL: Please follow parking steward's directions. Sanitise your hands at your own vehicle, *maintain 2m distance at venue at all times!* Vaccination certificates were checked online so please leave them in vehicle. Collect bib, carpark permit & rider/horse tags from yellow wagon, only 1 person in wagon at a time. Bibs and tags will not have been handled for at least 3 days. Hand sanitiser available in wagon.

GETTING READY: Pack your gloves, face mask and hand sanitiser/wipes in your bum bug.

STARTING: Start times are in ascending bib order and will be adhered to as far as possible. Please be mounted and near the timekeeper a few minutes before your start time. If the event starts running well ahead of schedule because of unexpected drop outs, the parking stewards will inform new arrivals that earlier slots are available. If you miss your slot, DON'T PANIC, the timekeeper will fit you in later in the schedule.

EN ROUTE: Route is marked in white chalk. Please slow down to pass other users, smile and be courteous. If you come across a group of riders, please keep your distance until there is plenty of space to overtake. If you come across a rider who has had an accident & needs assistance, contact the Ride Organiser immediately if the rider has not already done so. If it is critical that assistance is required before the First Aider arrives, you must ask the rider to put on their face mask if they can & you must wear yours and gloves. If CPR is required, this must be chest compressions only.

POST RIDE: Please return bib to holder, sanitise your hands, then collect rosette from a help yourself box in yellow wagon – please don't rummage – all the rosettes are identical! If you keep local group mileage cards, please fill out and find RO/Secretary who will witness your own pp signature. Please leave venue as soon as possible to reduce number of vehicles at the venue at any one time.

MISC: There is no toilet, water or catering van so please bring your own. If the weather is very hot, please ensure you bring plenty of water for cooling your horse at the end of the ride and for them to drink. Please maintain social distancing and keep dogs on leads.
